* English Saddle Fitting with Paulette Nuetzel, certified European Trained Saddle Master for Stubben Saddlery. *Want to come but don't have an English saddle?* Don't worry, Paulette will have a full line of NEW Stubben saddles to fit on your horse for you to use during the clinic. The early morning hours will be spent learning from Paulette how to fit you and your horse with the properly fitting english style saddle in the discipline of your choice; close contact (hunt), all-purpose, dressage and even gaited. She will also teach you the difference in english bridle ware; french cavesson or drop noseband or combined with flash; plaited reins vs laced reins vs web reins and when to use each. What is the difference between a crupper strap and a mounting strap or a German martingale from a running martingale or a crank cavesson from a plain cavesson. All this equipment will be there for you to see and learn about. Just bring your horse and his bridle with bit.

* Trudy Midas, president and owner of Espana Grooming Products, will then take over to show you proper grooming methods, answer questions and demonstrate her line of horse shampoos, medicated products for problem areas, and conditioners. She will have samples available and we will do a drawing for a prize basket of her Espana products.

* Last but certainly not least Mary will instruct you on English riding basics in a very friendly non-threatening manner. No riding level will be too elementary or no question will be too basic for Mary to answer or to instruct.
